What is the "Holy Year of Mercy"?

Pope Francis has said that the Holy Year of Mercy is a response to the world's need for a *revolution of tenderness*. *We are used to bad news, cruel news, and to even bigger atrocities, which offend the name and life of God.*

Ending those tragedies requires a spirit of mercy.

Also called Holy Years, jubilees normally occur every 25 years. They feature special celebrations and pilgrimages, calls for conversion and repentance, and the offer of special opportunities to experience God's grace through the sacraments, especially confession. Extraordinary holy years, such as the Holy Year of Mercy, are less frequent but offer the same opportunities. The last extraordinary jubilee was called by St. John Paul II in 1983 to mark the 1,950 years after the death of Jesus. John Paul also led the last holy year, known as the "Great Jubilee," in 2000. The Year of Mercy called for by Francis is the third "extraordinary" jubilee since the tradition began 700 years ago.

The year was unexpectedly announced by Pope Francis during a penitential service at St. Peter's Basilica on March 12. Beginning on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Dec. 8, 2015, it will end on the Solemnity of Christ the King, Nov. 20, 2016. Its motto is, "Merciful like the Father."

"Let us not forget that God forgives and God forgives always," said Pope Francis. "Let us never tire of asking for forgiveness. I am convinced that the whole Church — which has much need to receive mercy, because we are sinners — will find in this jubilee the joy to rediscover and render fruitful the mercy of God, with which we are all called to give consolation to every man and woman of our time," the pope said.
