St. Marguerite Bourgeoys: Marguerite Bourgeoys, CND, was a French nun and founder of the Congregation of Notre Dame of Montreal in the colony of New France, now part of Québec. Born in Troyes, she became part of a sodality, ministering to the poor from outside the convent. Marguerite aspired to a more just world. She formed respectful bonds with the First Nations, welcomed immigrants, including the Filles du Roy (King's Wards), and taught them how to survive in the new continent. Marguerite Bourgeoys was canonized in 1982 by Pope John Paul II and thus became the first female saint of Canada.
