Today's Gospel presents us with a man who has listened to the Word of God and knows it well. The scholar of the law wants to be precise in his keeping of the Law: who is my neighbour? To answer this, Jesus relates a parable. In the parable, the official religious personel pass by a man in need; contact with a corpse would have rendered them defiled and therefore unfit for Temple worship. Samartians were looked down upon by the Jews for both historical and religious reasons, yet the Samartian traveler is the one who does what the Law requires! What must I do? Show mercy.
