I want to take a quick moment to thank all the parishioners for their continued generosity. **First**, parishioners have contributed \$2,478.40 to help alleviate the humanitarian crises in sub-

Saharan Africa. More than 20 million people are risking mass starvation in South Sudan, Somalia, Yemen and Nigeria -- one of the worst humanitarian crises since the Second World War. We have already sent the contribution to the headquarters for Development and Peace in Montreal to meet the June 30 deadline. This is a substantial contribution for a parish of our size and means. Our donation will be matched by the federal government.

Second, sponsorship of new parish hall chairs has been \$3,420 which covers more than half of the total cost of the chairs. I want to thank the Ladies Auxiliary for taking the lead on this project. Thank you to everyone who has already sponsored a chair or two.
