## Welcome back to St. Elizabeth's!!

I can't explain how happy I am to see you back!! I missed you. I am sure that you are very happy to and I am looking forward to continuing our journey together. Our lives will forever be changed by the coming

of Covid 19. We have most of all realized how we depend on each other. It has been made abundantly clear to us that we are each others' keepers.

In line of being each others' keepers we have made a deliberate decision to open the church even though the requirements bestowed on us are enormous. Our first consideration for the reopening is to worship the Lord Our God from whom all our blessings flow. The second important consideration is to prevent everybody who comes to our church to contract the deadly virus. We make this commitment aware of the challenges ahead but strengthened by the communal spirit of the people of St. Elizabeth.

Before you leave your home for church, make sure you have no indication whatsoever that shows you may not be well. Stay at home if you have been in contact with people you cannot trace their history or movement. Come a few minutes before the Mass so that we can safely get you seated in church way in time for the Mass; these protocols seem to take quite a bit of time. Come with a mask and have it on at all times. Follow the ushers and beware of touching many surfaces. Avoid touching your facial parts.

We are so grateful for the volunteers that have been helping us and we are still asking for more. I hope you will be willing to assist in whatever role you may be comfortable to help to make sure our church remains open. If everybody follows the instructions and keeps the safe distance and sanitizes and wears their mask, with the Grace of God we shall be alright. Therefore tell the people: This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'Return to me,' declares the Lord Almighty, 'and I will return to you,' says the Lord Almighty. (Isaiah 1:3)

**Reopening of St. Elizabeth's:** We are pleased to be reopening for masses but with guidelines set out by the Archdiocese of Ottawa. Listed below are the important directives you need to know about coming to St. Elizabeth's for worship.

1. We are limited to 1/3 capacity.

2. Please wear a mask at all times when inside the church.

3. Do not touch face/eyes/nose/mouth

4. Apply Hand Sanitizer on Entering and Leaving the church.

5. Enter through the front doors only.

\* \*The side door and hallway by the Sacristy are out of bounds to all parishioners and ministers unless using the toilet facilities

6. Maintain social distancing (2m/6ft) from personnel outside of your family.

7. Follow arrows for direction of flow

\*\*Into the church and toward the altar up the middle aisle. Exit and return to pews via side aisles.

8. Sit in designated pew areas only; move down so that people do not need to pass by you.

9. When you exit the church, please depart front step area so everyone can socially distance.

10. Upon arriving home, wash hands thoroughly with soap and water; launder re-usable masks.

## **Please Stay Home If:**

\* You are COVID positive

\* Have any COVID symptoms

\* Have had recent contact with confirmed COVID patient (14 days)

\* You have recently travelled outside of Ottawa area

\* You are suffering seasonal allergies that cause sneezing

\* You have any concerns or are considered vulnerable
