I am very happy to say that Deacon's contract has been renewed and he will continue to serve with us for the near future. Most of the work the deacon does is behind the scenes; much more than serving at Sunday Masses. He for example runs the youth ministry, helps altar servers, helps in liturgical things, runs the Bible study, preaches at some Masses, does some plumbing, a little of electrical work, some repairs..you get the idea. We are very pleased that he allowed to continue serving with us and we wish him the very best.

Rev. Fr. Martin Okwudiba is a priest originally from Nigeria and incardinated to the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. He has been in Rome for his studies and after his studies he will be serving in our Archdiocese for an undetermined period of time.
