Mass in Honour of National Indigenous Peoples

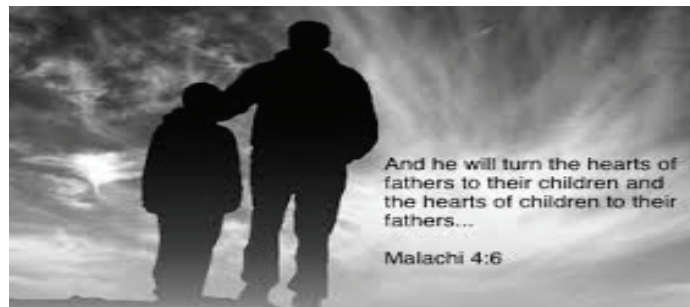
Day: On June 21st, Archbishop Marcel Dampousse will celebrate a Mass at St. Basil Parish, 904 Rex Avenue, Ottawa at 7 p.m. in honour of National Indigenous Peoples Day. All are welcome to attend!

Celebrating Indigenous Peoples: There are three different days in the secular and faith calendar to celebrate and remember Indigenous Peoples in Canada. To commemorate National Indigenous Peoples' Day (**June 21st**) in Canada, we encourage parishes to remember Indigenous Peoples and highlight opportunities in the local community for parishioners to join in Indigenous-led initiatives and events to celebrate this day. June 21st is "National Indigenous Peoples Day" in Canada. This is a secular day and not part of the liturgical calendar, but parishes are encouraged to pray for the Indigenous Peoples of Canada in their daily Mass. You might wish to add a special petition in the Prayers of the Faithful such as "May the Indigenous Peoples in Canada experience God's tender care and may we walk with our sisters and brothers in truth, healing and reconciliation, we pray to the Lord." September 30th is the "National Day for Truth and Reconciliation." The Catholic Church in Canada celebrates the "National Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples" on December 12th, the feast day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas.
