Fr. Martin's Corner

Tragedy befell my country a few days ago and this hit really close to home. A local Secondary (High) School; Mpondwe-Lubhiriha Secondary School was attacked by evil people who caused death and mayhem to these young souls. It is suspected that the attackers were members of the Allied Democratic Forces (ADF), a terrorist group based in the Congo Forests at the border with Uganda. These are suspected to be sponsored by the Islamic fundamentalist groups that have caused mayhem all over East, West and Central Africa. They are basically sponsored by Arab terrorist groups like Al Qaeda, Al Shabaab and Islamic state or ISIS. Their main agenda is to cause terror like gruesome murders, and pure evil.

I said this was close to home in two ways: This school that was attacked was built and run by a Canadian Not for Profit called Partnership for Opportunity Development Association (PODA), out of British Columbia. But more to home also, is that two young kids that were murdered were members of my extended family being children of my second cousin. The school that was attacked is around 67 miles from my home so the area is very familiar to me.

The story is that the attackers came after the students had gone to bed and started shooting and attacking others with machetes and crude weapons and set one building on fire. They killed 42 children in the most horrific of ways, injured some and kidnapped the

others whom they forced to carry the things that they had looted. Four of these have escaped and have just returned to school. I just wanted to share a little bit of this with you to ask for your prayers and also to continue praying for peace in the world. Most of these terrorists are very evil people. Some of them are young people who get kidnapped and are forced into these barbaric acts without their consent. Others are fortune hunters who enter into this evil because there is a better paycheck and simply do it for the money.

Sometimes external forces that are involved in these things and these forces are the least you would expect. Usually they leave very invisible footprints but they are mostly at the back end with financing and intelligence. Normally these have bigger political agendas. Let's continue to pray for peace and calm. I have visited this school before and I know the area. Seeing what just transpired there breaks my heart.
