In the Parish

Reopening of St. Elizabeth's: We are pleased to be reopening for masses but with guidelines set out by the Archdiocese of Ottawa. Listed below are the important directives you need to know about coming to St. Elizabeth's for worship.

1. We are limited to 1/3 capacity.

2. Please wear a mask at all times when inside the church.

3. Do not touch face/eyes/nose/mouth

4. Apply Hand Sanitizer on Entering and Leaving the church.

5. Enter through the front doors only.

* *The side door and hallway by the Sacristy are out of bounds to all parishioners and ministers unless using the toilet facilities

6. Maintain social distancing (2m/6ft) from personnel outside of your family.

7. Follow arrows for direction of flow

**Into the church and toward the altar up the middle aisle. Exit and return to pews via side aisles.

8. Sit in designated pew areas only; move down so that people do not need to pass by you.

9. When you exit the church, please depart front step area so everyone can socially distance.

10. Upon arriving home, wash hands thoroughly with soap and water; launder re-usable masks.

Please Stay Home If:

- * You are COVID positive
- * Have any COVID symptoms

* Have had recent contact with confirmed COVID patient (14 days)

* You have recently travelled outside of Ottawa area

* You are suffering seasonal allergies that cause sneezing

* You have any concerns or are considered vulnerable
