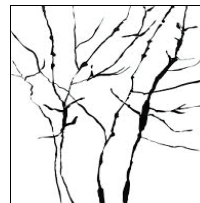
**World Day of Prayer:**

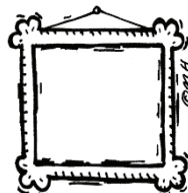
