Norms for Lenten Observance:

• Good Friday is a day of **fast** and **abstinence.** Fasting is for all persons who are 18 to 59 unless prevented by poor health. **Fasting** means one full meal is allowed. Two other meals may be taken according to one's needs. Eating between meals in not allowed although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence from meat is for all persons who are 14 and older unless prevented by poor health. In the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
