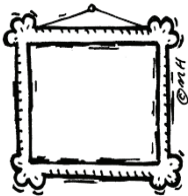
Need for Liturgical Ministers for All Parish Masses:

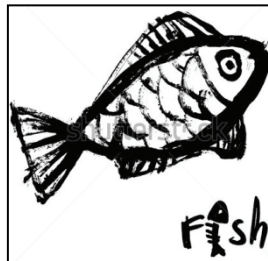
