Need for Liturgical Ministers for All Parish Masses:

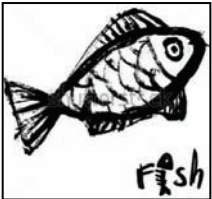
The parish needs community members to become Commentators, Lectors, and Eucharistic Ministers.

50th Anniversary Lenten Fish Dinner:

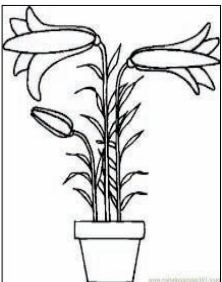

Chrism Mass at Notre Dame Cathedral:

March 31 at 7:30 p.m. Everyone is welcome to join Archbishop Prendergast for the Chrism Mass and a reception in the Cathedral Hall immediately following the Mass. At the Chrism Mass, the Archbishop blesses the three oils — the oil of catechumens, the oil of the infirm and holy chrism — which will be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the archdiocese for the year. The priests of the archdiocese are also present.
