Financial report on regular Parish Operations to the end of December 2023.

Collections - the largest taxable collection areas include \$115,700 for regular collections, donations of over \$28,000, hall rental for a little over \$23,100 and \$6,300 via Canada Helps

Non-taxable revenues include \$33,800 from Parochial organizations, a \$25K bequest, and \$6,200 from candle sales\$\;\frac{75,977}{70tal revenue}\$

Expenses
Net Income - (Deficit)

\$275,540 **\$ (6,533)**

Definitions:

Collections: White envelopes, online collections, maintenance, donations. Rent (taxable) and special collections

Other revenues: All other revenues (poor fund, rent (non-taxable), bequests, parochial organizations, etc) excluding collections above. Expenses: All regular operational expenses (salaries, office Administration, Diocesan Admin tax, maintenance, liturgical, etc. exceeded \$275,500.

In addition to salaries, the major expenses include \$28,344 for Diocesan Administration Tax, \$26,010 for heating, hydro and water, \$15,439 for musicians, \$9,557 for plumbing work including the installation of the plumbing back flow preventer, \$5,984 for snow clearing and \$2,900 for roof repairs.

The deficit for 2023 is (6,533). This deficit is smaller than anticipated due to a bequest of \$25,000.00 over \$11,500 from the Ladies Auxiliary, \$2,500 from the K of C and \$7,700 from the Hungarian Community, and \$7,700 from the Poor Fund. As an aside, the surplus in 2021 has offset the combined deficit for 2022 and 2023.
