

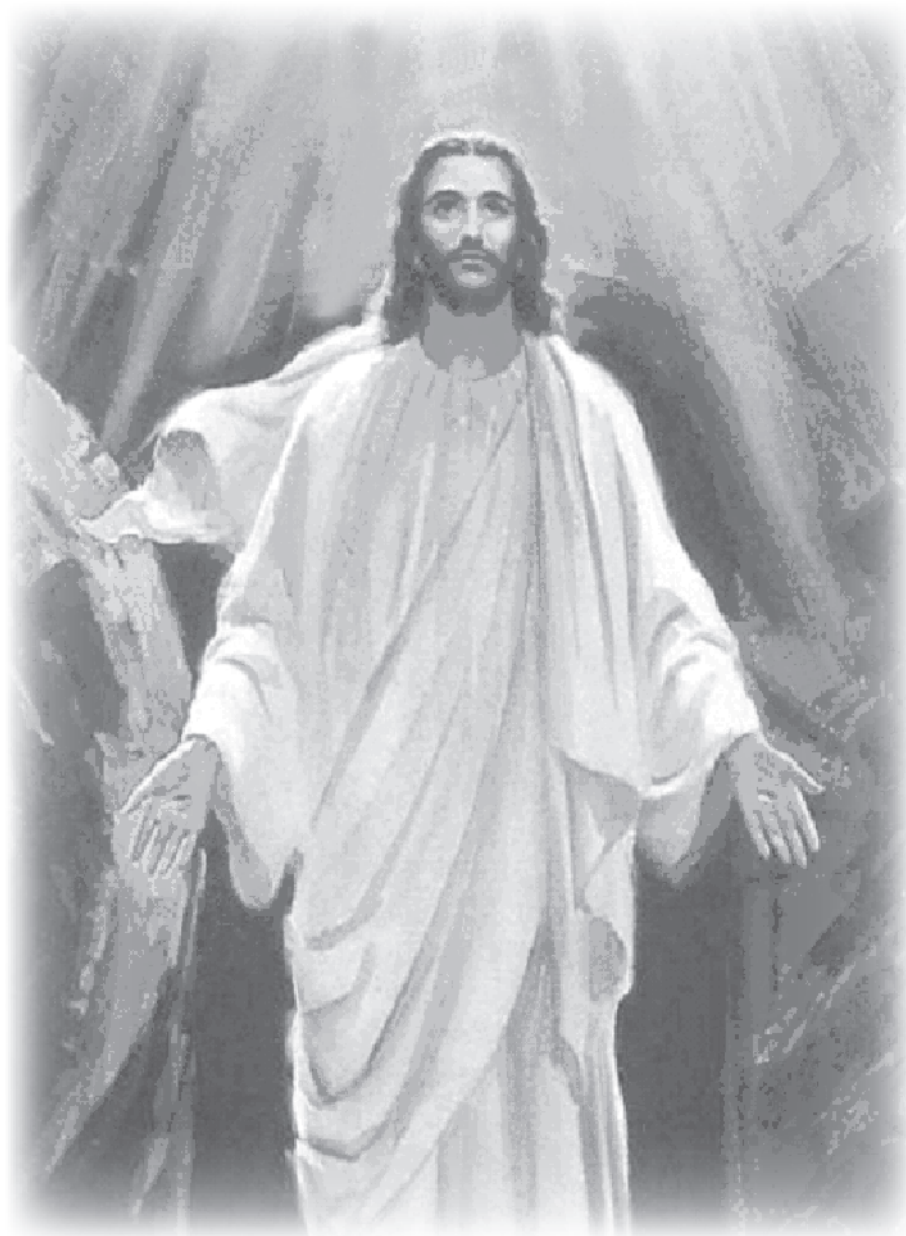

Fr. Martin's Easter Message:

Dear brothers and sisters,

Happy Resurrection Sunday!!

Jesus has risen from the dead. This announcement resounds in the Church throughout the world along

with the song of Hallelujah, He is alive forever in our midst. This Good News has lit up like a new flame in the Holy Night of the Vigil, in the night of a world facing crucial challenges, because of wars, and because of all the tests that hinder the life of humanity.

We must be grateful for the grace of celebrating this day as a family to celebrate his resurrection. It is a Sunday full of joy, a joy that becomes contagious, because it has to make us lose fear. It is a "contagion, which is transmitted from heart to heart, because every human heart awaits this Good News. It is the contagion of hope: "My love and my hope have truly risen!", tells us the Paschal sequence that we read before the Gospel.

It is not a magic formula that makes problems disappear. We must understand that the resurrection of Christ is the victory of love over the root of evil, a victory that does not "go over" suffering and death, but goes beyond them, opening a path in the abyss, transforming evil. in good, distinctive sign of God's power ". (Pope Francis, Easter message 2020).

As a parish, in the midst of this Easter joy, I want to invite you to see this Easter celebration reflected in our commitment to faith, and in the increase of our love for the Risen One, for the Church and materialized in love for the parish.

Sadly, we have had many parishioners that have died and some are unwell and cannot celebrate this Easter with us. To them we send the good news of Easter. The Lord is Risen! He has defeated death. He dies no more.

Finally, I want to thank all the volunteers of our parish. Ushers, Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers, Sacristans, Altar Servers and Musicians, who in communion with the parish staff have made a great effort so that the liturgy on these special days of Holy Week was very beautiful, organized and done with great dignity. Know that behind each liturgical act there is a lot of work and organization.

Many have worked hard for this to be carried out with order and decorum. Deacon Fred in a special way has done an amazing job behind the scenes. I want all the volunteers to know that you are very important to me and have a very important place in my heart.
