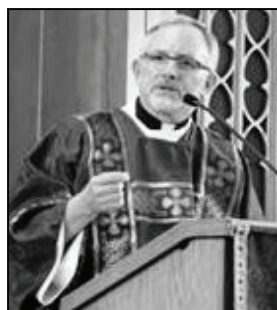

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

It is an honour and a pleasure to be assigned to St. Elizabeth's to serve as the parish deacon. Allow me to introduce myself and to share some of what a deacon is and what a deacon does.

I was born in Halifax Nova Scotia in 1957. I am a graduate of the Royal Military College in

Kingston, have two degrees in Electrical Engineering, served in the navy for 21 years and, for the past 21, have worked in industry in program management related mainly to naval engineering. In 1980 I married my high school sweetheart Sarah. We have been blessed with three children, all of whom are married. In April we become grandparents! I love many sports. I enjoy hiking and play guitar, banjo and mandolin. Together Sarah and I share a passion for cooking and gardening. Sarah is an amazing quilter and holds several degrees, including a Master's Degree in Theology from St. Paul University. I have been a Knight of Columbus for about 20 years.

Secondly, what is a deacon? A deacon is ordained by a bishop for service in the Church. I am what is known as a "permanent deacon." This means that I am not eligible to become a priest. By my introduction you will note that I am married – most of us are. I was ordained by Archbishop Gervais in 2007.

The ministry performed by deacons include proclaiming the Gospel, giving homilies, service at the altar, giving blessings and presiding at baptisms, marriages and funeral liturgies. We may not celebrate Mass, hear confession or anoint the sick. Deacons may wear "roman collars." One way to tell a deacon from a priest is that we wear our stoles diagonally across our torso.

I have previously served as a parish deacon at St. Patrick's Fallowfield and at St. John the Apostle. During my time in formation and since ordination I have also served at the Shepherds of Good Hope, the Royal Ottawa Hospital, in a multi-denominational spiritual care ministry and, for the past seven years, with our indigenous community at Kateri Native Ministry.

I look forward to getting to know you personally. Please forgive me if I forget names from time to time. While the formal way to address a deacon is "deacon" (not "Father") or "deacon Fred" please feel free to just call me "Fred."
