**Bible Study:** Deacon Fred will facilitate a study of the Gospel of Matthew as part of our Parish Lenten Journey. It will take place on **Tuesday, March 28th after the 9:00 a.m.** The last gathering will be on Tuesday, April 18th.

### **Norms for Lenten Observance:**

- Good Friday is a day of **fast** and **abstinence**. Fasting is for all persons who are 18 to 59 unless prevented by poor health. **Fasting** means one full meal is allowed. Two other meals may be taken according to one's needs. Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

**Abstinence** from meat is for all persons who are 14 and older unless prevented by poor health. In the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
