Bible Study: Deacon Fred will facilitate a study of the Gospel of Matthew as part of our Parish Lenten Journey. It will take place this **Tuesday, March 28th after the 9:00 a.m.** The last gathering will be on Tuesday, April 18th.

Norms for Lenten Observance:

- Good Friday is a day of **fast** and **abstinence**. Fasting is for all persons who are 18 to 59 unless prevented by poor health. **Fasting** means one full meal is allowed. Two other meals may be taken according to one's needs. Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence from meat is for all persons who are 14 and older unless prevented by poor health. In the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.

World Youth Day: We are fortunate in our parish to have a young woman, Mary C. who will be attending World Youth Day in Lisbon Portugal this August. If you would like to support our Mary please consider a donation. Thank you in advance for your support.
