The Logo of the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall: Strong, Vibrant, Transparent, and Youthful: Four transparent

colours (can't be seen in this logo) created in the style of a stained glass window, paying tribute to previous generations and history of the church in Canada, and specifically in the iconic historical Churches in Ottawa and Cornwall. The transparency of the colours alludes to the transparent nature of the new Archdiocese, as well as the Church. The four main colours are: green, symbolizing the life of the Church; purple, a colour of preparation and repentance; yellow, the light of Christ; and blue, the water of our baptism. The colours merge to create a strong solid cross, the base of which incorporates the look of water. "Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit." 1213 CCC The water also symbolizes the connected rivers running through both Ottawa and Cornwall.

From Archbishop Prendergast: Spiritual Communion: The Church encourages frequent, even daily Holy Communion, but if at any time we cannot go to Mass, we can still unite ourselves to the Eucharist through making a spiritual Communion. Here is the Act of Spiritual Communion written by St. Alphonsus de Liguori:

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things, and I desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace you as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to you.

Never permit me to be separated from you.

Amen.
