## <u>Central Themes in Recent Church Teaching on the Environment:</u> <u>6. Solidarity</u>



Because creation has been entrusted to the human race as a whole and not to any one person, group, or nation, its resources and responsibility for its care must be shared by all. This implies solidarity

between individuals, peoples, and nations, as well as solidarity," "intergenerational that is. of the environment for future preservation generations. Also of key importance is our solidarity with the poor, whose ability to access resources is often limited. Since environmental degradation is often related to poverty, solidarity demands that structural forms of poverty be addressed. It also demands that those who use and exploit resources bear the true costs of this use, which must take into account the environmental repercussions on future generations. In summary, solidarity with respect to the environment is based on the requirements of justice and the common good, which is understood to extend not only between those living, but forward, to those not yet born.
