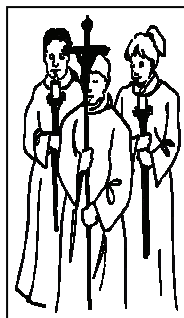

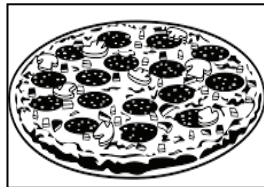
Thank you to Nancy Wilkinson and all her helpers:
