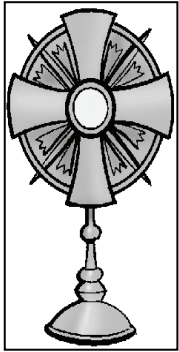
Ladies Auxiliary Coffee Sunday/Bake Sale:

Fr. Martin's Corner

Have you ever thought about the priests' vestments and what they might mean? If not, then this may interest you. During the vestment before Mass the priests adorns himself with the following:

Amice: Symbolizes the defence against the temptations of the devil and symbolizes the moderation of words. He says the following prayer: "Lord, set the helmet of salvation on my head to fend off all the assaults of the devil."

Alb: This is the white vestment that symbolizes the purity of heart that the priest must bring to the altar. He says the prayer: Make me white O Lord and cleanse my heart, that being made white in the blood of the Lamb, I may deserve an eternal reward."

The Cincture: Symbolizes self restraint and purity. He says the prayer: "Gird me Oh Lord with the cincture of purity and quench in my heart the fire of

concupiscence that the virtue of continence and chastity may abide in me."

Stole: Symbolizes priestly power and authority. He says the prayer: "Lord restore the stole of immortality which I lost through the collusion of our first parents; and unworthy as I am to approach thy sacred mysteries, may I yet gain eternal joy."

Chasuble: This is worn above all other vestments and symbolizes the virtue of charity. The priest says the prayer: "Oh Lord who has said my yoke is sweet and my burden light, grant that I may so carry it as to merit thy graces.

You may also not know that the Bishop's cassock has:

- 33 buttons which represent Our Lord Jesus Christ's earthly years.
- 5 Buttons on each wrist which represent the 5 wounds Jesus suffered on the Cross
- When the Bishop's hands are held together, the buttons on each hand become 10 which represent the 10 Commandments.
