Expenses: All regular operational expenses (salaries, office,

Diocesan Admin tax, maintenance, liturgical, etc.

We are currently running a deficit of \$ 10,662. Deficit is smaller due to an unanticipated bequest of \$25,000, over \$11,000 from the Ladies Auxiliary, \$2,500 from the Knights of Columbus and \$5,600 from the Hungarian Community.

In addition to salaries, the major YTD expenses include \$19,500 for Diocesan Administration Tax, \$17,100 for heating, hydro and water, \$10,690 for musicians, \$7,100 for rectory/sacristy, \$6,200 for the new storage cabinets at the back of the church, over \$4,200 for the back flow plumbing work and \$2,500 for walk way repairs.



a loved one. The front cover of the missal would bear the name of the donor and the missals will be in the pews this year.




