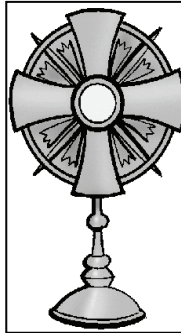


St. Elizabeth Christmas Bazaar:
