

Two New Saints for Canada: Without a canonization ceremony, Pope Francis declared two new saints for the Canada. They were pioneers of the Canadian Catholic Church. The two saints are Marie de l'Incarnation, a Ursuline nun from France who travelled to Quebec in 1639. She is known as the Mother of the Canadian Church.

Francois de Laval arrived in Quebec 20 years after Marie de l'Incarnation and became the first bishop of Quebec.
