The Ladies Auxiliary will be hosting a Coffee Sunday/Bake Sale on **Sunday, November 6th after the 9:00 a.m. and**

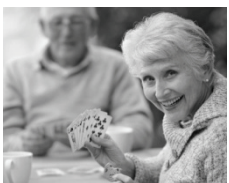

Now we are trying to construct another room; the meeting room for catechetical preparations with an annex for the Grotto of Mother Mary the Undoer of Knots. This new construction shall give us space out of the church where people can do other activities like meetings and devotions. It is expected to accommodate about 22,000 people every week.
