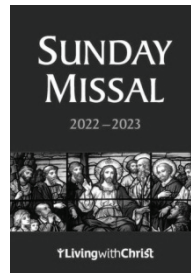
UGANDA PROJECT 2023:

With gratitude for the support towards Project Uganda of 2022, I would like to propose the Uganda Project 2023. This project is in

support of the Local Church in Uganda which was upgraded to parish level in 2021. Our last project was to construct the Sanctuary and The Sacristy plus wardrobe for church vestments. Now we are trying to construct another room; the meeting room for catechetical preparations with an annex for the Grotto of Mother Mary the Undoer of Knots. This new construction shall give us space out of the church where people can do other activities like meetings and devotions. It is expected to accommodate about 22,000 people every week. The estimated cost for this project is \$ 38,750. Will you help me to assist my people with this worthy cause?
