Every death is a fright on its own but this time I personally was almost getting to the breaking point and I have heard the same from parishioners as well. It feels like death is coming really close. We have always looked out for each other and I appreciate the Masses offered for those that have passed. We continue to pray for each other and pray for the repose of the soul of our dear loved ones.
