Our Sunday Theme: They Do Good.....But Are Not of Our group.

Today's Readings offer us more than enough Food For Thought. But the main theme of our Weekend Liturgy is the one presented in the First Reading and in the first part of the Gospel. It touches on the fanaticism that we sometimes harbour, often unconsciously, to those who may do very good things but do not necessarily belong to our camp. Jesus tells us that the Spirit acts freely through any person and is not compelled to work only within our artificial boundaries. We belong to one family, and any kind of division is not from God.

The Second Reading could be used as an example to prove this point. Aren't there Christians, who as James says, pile up riches, don't share their goods with the poor and exploit their workers and are not kind to strangers? On the other hand, don't we know non-believers who are good and generous and kind and sensitive to injustice towards the poorest and the defenseless? There is also a call for us to admit our mistakes and our fragility. When we realize that some of our attitudes are incompatible with the Christian Option we must have the courage to cut them away even though they may cause us a little pain.
