Early beginnings of St. Leo's Church

The formation of St. Leo Catholic Church began in the early 1980's. It is the first and only Catholic Church in Brooklin.

We started slowly. Fr. Oliver Moloney was our first parish priest. There was a small Catholic school in Brooklin West of Hwy 12 and that's where we had our first masses. We had no hall for fund raising so we rented the Brooklin Community Centre, which is on Cassels St.

A few years after the parish began, Fr. Moloney decided we should do a census in the village of Brooklin and surrounding area. He formed two teams of two members each. I was on one team and Angelina Steenstra was on the other team. I forgot the exact number of families, but I believe it was within the range of 40-50, small beginnings but it was a start.

Soon thereafter, the diocese of Toronto sent us a portable church. It held about 120 people. It came in 5 or 6 sections and had to be bolted together. It was near Hwy 12 and east of the school. It was our church for the next 15-20 years.

I distinctly remember there were a few years in the portable when our income was in the range of 40,000.00 dollars. I don't know how Father paid the bills, but he managed somehow.

In 1994, the parish formed a KofC Council #11528. Mr. Vince Corvinelli had a 3-bedroom bungalow on Columbus Rd. which he used as his office. He was a charter member of the KofC and he generously gave us the basement, which was finished, and we held our meetings there for the next few years at no charge.

In the late 1990s, the Diocese of Toronto sent out a team of officials to discuss building a permanent church. Neil McCarthy was one of the officials. We had grown as a parish and we needed more room, a bigger church. By this time, there was a new catholic school between Hwy 12 and closer to Thickson Rd on Watford Street. Jeananne Ralph was the first principal of the new school and still active in St. Leo today.

We had a generous offer of 10 acres on which to build a new church, but it was not near the school. Fr. Moloney insisted the new church was to be built near the school. This was a very wise decision as the school children are enjoying the benefits to this day.

Fr. Moloney retired, and was replaced by Fr. Phil Jones. It was under Fr. Phil that the church was built and completed.

We have been blessed with many hard-working priests and parishioners since St. Leo's beginning. Fr. Phil Jones was replaced by Fr. Charles Forget who actually grow up in the Whitby area. He added many of the essentials in the church, one is the huge crucifix on the wall in the back of the altar, over the tabernacle. He was our parish priest for 11 years and now we are enjoying our current priest Fr. Mounir.

We can boast of one of the most beautiful churches in this area, and we have organizations within the parish which are secondary to none. We support many charitable organizations within the Durham region.

We pray the blessings will continue and we may enjoy the privileges of this parish for many years to come. It has been a blessing and a great privilege to be a part of it.


