## St. Maria Faustina Kowalska

#### Feast Day: October 5

Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska of the Blessed Sacrament was born as Helena Kowalska, in Poland on August 25, 1905. In 1924, Faustina experienced her first vision of Jesus. According to Faustina, Jesus instructed her to leave for Warsaw immediately and

join a convent. On February 22, 1931, Faustina was visited by Jesus, who presented himself as the "King of Divine Mercy" wearing a white garment with red and pale rays coming from his heart. She was asked to become the apostle and secretary of God's mercy, a model of how to be merciful to others, and an instrument for reemphasizing



God's plan of mercy for the world.

On May 1, 1933 she took her final vows in Lagiewniki and became a perpetual sister of Our Lady of Mercy. According to Faustina's diary, on Good Friday, April 19, 1935, Jesus told her he wanted the Divine Mercy image publicly honored. In October 1936, during an eight-day retreat, she was led by an angel to what she called the "chasms of hell," which she described in her diary as a place of "great torture" and "fire that will penetrate the soul without destroying it — a terrible suffering." This hell was filled with darkness, and, despite that darkness, "the devils and the souls of the damned see each other and all the evil, both of others and their own." On October 5, 1938, Faustina passed away and currently rests at the Basilica of Divine Mercy in Krakow, Poland.

Her entire life, in imitation of Christ's, was to be a sacrifice - a life lived for others. In her daily life she was to become a doer of mercy, bringing joy and peace to others, and by writing about God's mercy, she was to encourage others to trust in Him and thus prepare the world for His coming again. Her special devotion to Mary Immaculate and to the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation gave her the strength to bear all her sufferings as an offering to God on behalf of the Church and those in special need, especially great sinners, and the dying.

#### Reflection

Devotion to God's Divine Mercy bears some resemblance to devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In both cases, sinners are encouraged not to despair, not to doubt God's willingness to forgive them if they repent. As Psalm 136 says in each of its 26 verses, "God's love [mercy] endures forever."


