Saint Vincent de Paul feast day Sept. 27:

He studied theology at the University of Toulouse. At the age of nineteen years, on September 23 1600, he was ordained as a priest but because he was still not yet 24 years, he declined to take the role of a parish priest and continued with his theology studies.

After graduating with a Bachelor of Theology Degree from the University of Toulouse on October 12 1604, the following year, he was captured and enslaved for two years in Tunis, Tunisia. After being sold to several

masters, his last master helped him escape back to France in 1607.

After landing in France, Vincent went to Rome to study for nearly two years then came back to France. The initial life of leisure that St Vincent de Paul had yearned for was changed after he heard the confession of a dying peasant, and he experienced a change of heart.

After King Louis XIII died, his wife Queen Anne took over the rule of France as a regent and nominated Vincent de Paul as her spiritual adviser.

Vincent was introduced to many poor families by the Daughters of Charity. He tended to the poor by bringing them food and other essential supplies just to at least make their lives bearable and comfortable.

Feast of the Archangels, Michael, Gabriel and Raphael Sep. 29: The Church honors the archangels with such a high ranking. Their role in our life is different from the saints. We pray to the saints for their intercession, but we also look to their lives for imitation and role modeling. But angels are different. The angels are spiritual creatures created by God for a particular purpose. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls "angels" is a truth of faith. The witness of Scripture is as clear as the unanimity of Tradition (CCC 328).

Angels are spiritual creatures who glorify God without ceasing and who serve his saving plans for other creatures: "The angels work together for the benefit of us all" (St. Thomas Aquinas, *STh* I, 114, 3, ad 3).

The angels surround Christ their Lord. They serve him especially in the accomplishment of his saving mission to men. The Church venerates the angels who help her on her earthly pilgrimage and protect every human being (CCC, 350-352).

Angels truly exist, but we need to push through all those cutesy "angel on my shoulder" and little cherub angels and recognize the dignity and higher order of these spiritual beings. They were created to be with God, to contemplate God in His beatific vision.


