LOCAL HOSPITALS AND EMERGENCY PASTORAL VISITATION

From Last Sunday's reflection: Jesus in the gospel, placed his fingers into the ears of the deaf, and touched his tongue. He said to his senses, "be opened" (Ephphatha). Immediately the man's ears were opened, his tongue was released, and he spoke plainly."

At baptism, the priest uses the same word which Jesus did, be opened (**Ephphatha**); he does that over the ears, eyes, nose, and the throat with the sign of the cross. In many of the ancient catholic baptismal rites; the baptized person is signed with 36 crosses using the Chrism oil/Myron after the water Baptism. All joints and all the senses all over the body are marked by the sign of the cross with this scented oil (usually Extra Virgin Olive Oil).

This is why in baptism, and in all the sacraments we consecrate our bodies to God. We wash in the blessed water in order to be cleansed from impurities and evil of the original sin. We use the holy oils to heal us, to consecrate us and make us ready vessels to the dwelling of God.

Nonetheless, we may lose this grace if we sin or go the way of the world. Jesus told us unless we become like little children we cannot enter the kingdom. All of us at various stages of our life, we need and must renew our dedication. We regularly in need of recovering our purity and innocence from the fallen ways of the world. As adults we turn (to the Sacraments) and seek guidance and discernment from the Holy Spirit in all our doings.

Every believer needs discernment, in their vocation, & while using their gifts, and faculties! In fact, without discernment, we cannot progress in our faith. Without sensitivity to the Holy Spirit we are not able to subject our gifts to God. If we are careless and if we are hasty in what we do, the enemy makes use of our gifts.

Jesus taught us on various occasions this principle of following God: He repeatedly said, "What I see my Father doing, I do." Through discernment we can watch and pray to see how the Spirit is moving then we follow in the footsteps of the Holy Spirit.

In order to facilitate and subject our beings to God, it is good to adopt a prayer to the Holy Spirit in our life. This below is one example:

"Oh Holy Spirit of God, abide with me. Inspire all my thoughts; pervade my imaginations; suggest all my decisions; order all my doings. Be with me in my speech and in my silence, in my haste and in my leisure, in company and in solitude, in the freshness of the morning and in the weariness of the evening. Bless, enlighten and consecrate all of my senses, infuse them with you holy light for your glory, and for the love of my neighbors. Give me this grace so that I may humbly rejoice in your company always." Amen.
