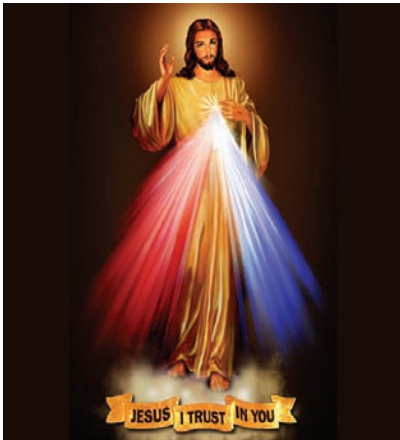

NEW PROVINCIAL GUIDELINES

Dear Parishioners:

As of April 3, 2021, the Provincial Government has mandated new restrictions for at least one month. In accordance with the Provincial mandate and the Diocesan policy, we will do our best to comply with what is being asked of us. Moving forward all religious services can accommodate up to **15% of seating capacity** for places of worship. That means we cannot have more than 55 people at one time at Blessed Sacrament Church and 30 people at St. Anthony Daniel Scotland. We will have the Hall available on Sunday to accommodate another 50 at Blessed Sacrament.

Family members of the same household can occupy one pew. However, we ask that no more than **2 individuals** (non-family members) occupy the same pew. So, for example, if a couple is occupying a pew then no other individual outside of that family can share the same pew.

In order to be fair to everyone, you will need to sign up in advance, week to week for the Masses on Saturday and Sunday. No sign up necessary for weekday Mass. Sign-up will begin no earlier than Tuesday leading up to the weekend and only by phone (519-449-5143) or email: blessedsacramentburford@hamiltondiocese.com First come first serve.

Fr. Peter will not record your reservation. Our Secretary, Marzena, has done an exceptional job of tracking attendance for the Easter Triduum and she will continue to do so for the month of April.

I would encourage you to attend a weekday Mass if the Sunday Mass is fully booked. I ask for the next month that the parishioners from Burford only attend Mass at Blessed Sacrament. St. Anthony Daniel’s capacity is less and it’s only fair to allow the parishioners from Scotland priority seating.

Finally, there will be an extra Mass celebrated each Wednesday at 7:00 pm at St. Anthony Daniel to help accommodate more people. Fr. Al MacMillan has also graciously offered to celebrate an extra Sunday Mass for the people in Scotland at 10:00 am. We are blessed to have Fr. Al generously offer his services for the next 3 Sundays.
