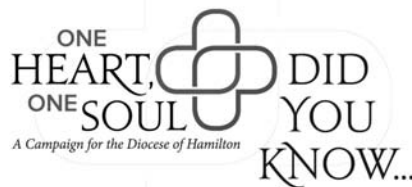
Easter Flower Collection: Will take place after Mass today and next Sunday. Your generosity will help make the Church beautiful for Easter.

Dear Parishioners:

The Diocesan Campaign *One Heart, One Soul* has been launched officially in both the Parish of St. Anthony Daniel and Blessed Sacrament. This is an exciting time in the life of our communities. There has even been a write up of our involvement in the Campaign in the *Catholic Register* and in *The Burford Advance*. The word is getting out. The local theme for St. Anthony Daniel is *Lifting Up Our Faith* and for Blessed Sacrament, *Raising the Roof of Faith*. The Parish statements you will receive soon will explain why we have chosen those two themes.

In the coming days you should be receiving your personal Campaign package by mail. If you do not receive it by April 16, then please notify the Parish office. It's possible we may have an incorrect address. The Campaign package will contain a letter from the Bishop, from me and the Parish Statement. There will be an explanation about the pledge and the contribution you can make over a three year period.

To assist you, a volunteer from the Parish will be contacting you. He/she will bring the pledge card that will need to be filled out. The pledge card can either be filled out by the volunteer or you can fill out the card yourself, place it in the envelope and return it to the volunteer. We would prefer that the volunteer retrieve the enclosed pledge cards so that we can track those who have been reached. Moreover, the volunteer is there to answer any questions you may have. The visit should take not more than 20 minutes.

We hope to have most, if not all, of the pledges by June of this year. Remember, the pledge is the commitment you will make over a three year period. Please review all of the material, pray about it and most of all, don't hesitate to ask questions, either with one of the volunteers or by approaching me.

As Bishop Crosby stated in the video, let's all do our part by leaning in and getting involved.
