





THE POPE'S PRAYER INTENTIONS FOR AUGUST: ARTISTS

This month Pope Francis has called us to pray for Artists. That through their creativity they may help us to discover the beauty of creation.

MARRIAGE TIP

Love is a commitment, one that has bright days, gray days and everything in-between days. When we persevere and work through our struggles in positive ways, our relationship grows stronger and more resilient. When we understand that God is with us in our marriage, it reminds us that we are never alone. As Paul wrote to the Philippians, "I can do all things through him who strengthens me." (4:13). When we turn to God together in daily prayer, our love grows and deepens and is capable of handling any day that comes our way.

PARENTING TIP

Our children are constantly learning about life and how to live in the world by all they hear and experience. Stories are great ways to teach our children, but we don't always have to reach for a book to tell a story. Family stories about an event that taught you a lesson, demonstrated love, connected you to your faith, and describes family traditions are great teaching tools. Setting aside a weekly family storytelling session is a great way to bond, pass on traditions and teach the lessons that have value to you and your family.

MASS INTENTIONS NEEDED
