## **CATHOLIC FUNERALS**

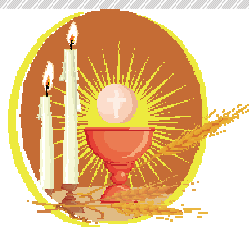

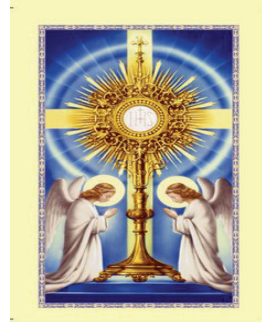
### GRANDPARENTS WORKSHOP

The above question is what Jesus posed to His disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane after celebrating the Last Supper. 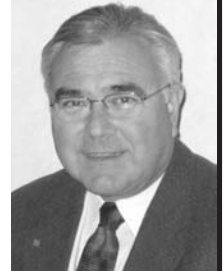
