Dear Parishioners:

On the feast of the Holy Family we have a chance to look into the life of exemplary parents: Mary and Joseph. When God speaks they listen. 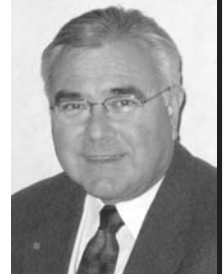
