

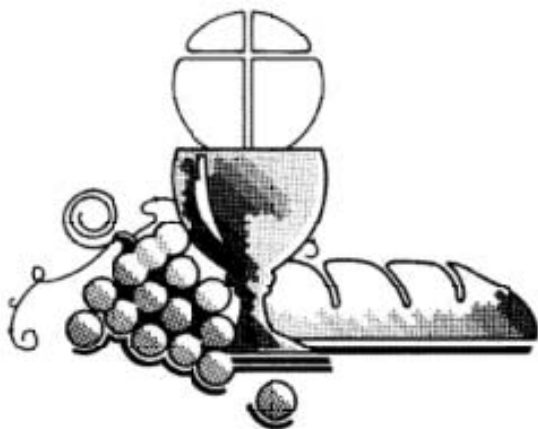

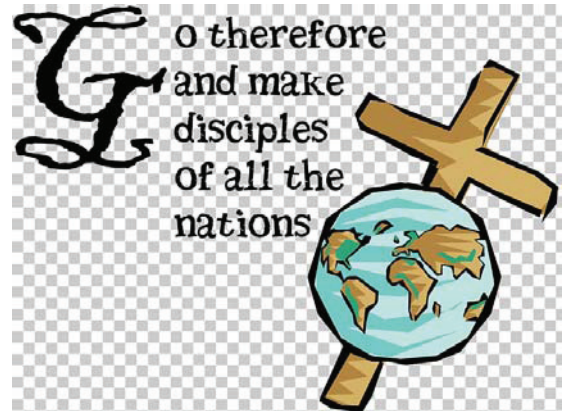

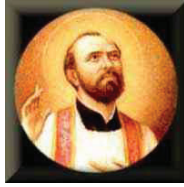

Christian Unity



Dear Parishioners:

Christians are reminded of Jesus' prayer for his disciples that "they may be one so that the world may believe" (see John 17.21). Hearts are touched and Christians come together to pray for their unity. Congregations and parishes all over the world exchange preachers or arrange special ecumenical celebrations and prayer services throughout the year.

The event that touches off this special experience is the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Traditionally the week of prayer is celebrated January 18-25, between the feasts of St. Peter and St. Paul. The theme for the week of prayer in 2021, "*Abide in my love and you shall bear much fruit*" inspired by John 15:5-9.

Here in our own area we see how vibrant ecumenism is among the different churches. Under normal circumstance we celebrate our ecumenical Advent service in late November and in the coming weeks and months we will celebrate our annual Day of Prayer (March), Decoration Sunday Service in August and the Remembrance Day Service in November. Moreover, we see how the different members of the respective communities will support each other's events and projects, such as our annual Chicken BBQ, the United Church's annual Bazaar or the local food bank run by the Baptist Church. Even during the pandemic we try to be supportive of one another. When we received the call to help the migrant Farmworkers in quarantine, the other churches have also supported our outreach and ministry. Whether through prayer and song, service and social engagements, we see the handiwork of the Spirit bringing us ever so closer to the vision of unity and love envisioned by Christ.
