News in the Diocese

Annual Bible Sunday: The Second Annual Bible Sunday will be observed in the Diocese of Hamilton on Sunday, February 3, 2019. The focus of this year’s observance is “*Listening to God’s Word at Mass*”. Two special presentations on the Gospel of Luke will be offered by Fr. Michael Patella, O.S.B. St. Michael Parish in Waterloo (2:00-3:30 pm) and the Cathedral Basilica of Hamilton (7:00-8:30 pm). Plan to attend one of these presentations which will outline what we will hear at the Sunday liturgies, the Year of Luke.



Dear Parishioners:

His Excellency, Douglas Crosby, OMI, DD, Bishop of Hamilton, has declared that once a year, the Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Diocese will celebrate Bible Sunday. Next Sunday (February 3) we will mark the Second Annual Bible Sunday. The Bishop explained that this special dedication is a response to Pope Francis’ invitation. In his Apostolic Letter at the closing of the Jubilee Year on Mercy (2016), the Holy Father wishes, “that God’s Word be increasingly celebrated, known and disseminated, so that the mystery of love stemming from this font of mercy may be ever better understood.” (Apostolic Letter *Misericordia et misera*, n. 7).

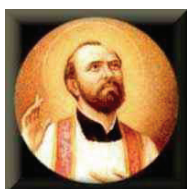
