

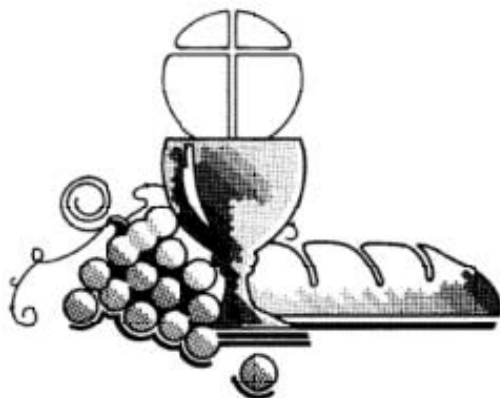

In today's reading we hear the refrain from the Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 23): "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want."
