

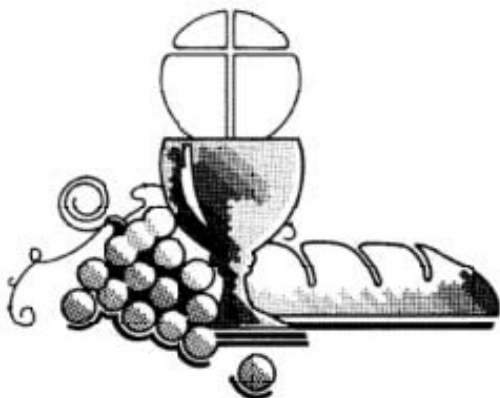

CATHOLIC FUNERALS

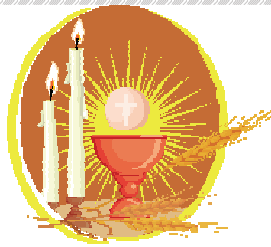

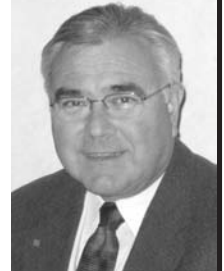
