Have I spoken behind someone else's back?

Am I sincere in my dealings with others?

Am I critical, negative or uncharitable in my thoughts of others?

**You shall not desire your neighbor's wife.**

Have I consented to impure thoughts?

Have I caused them by the use of pornography?

Do I seek to control my sexual imagination?

**You shall not desire your neighbor's goods.**

Do I envy the families or possessions of others?

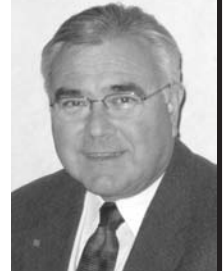
