

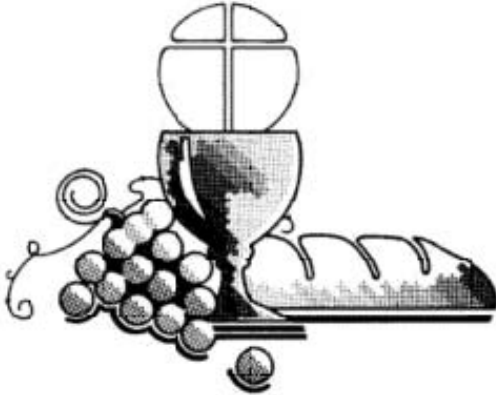

‘One Heart, One Soul’ kickoff is March 25

The One Heart, One Soul Campaign for the Diocese of Hamilton is about to reach high gear! The 14 Pilot Wave Parishes have been busy planning the projects of theirs that will benefit from the campaign, and a public kickoff Mass will be held at noon on Monday, March 25, Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord, at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King. The Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Douglas Crosby and followed by a reception at the Cathedral.

The Pilot Wave Parishes will be holding kickoffs for their own efforts in April. Three additional waves over the next two years will allow every Parish in the Diocese to participate. Most of the funds from the three-year campaign will go to Parish projects, with a special emphasis on the Parishes most in need. A number of diocesan ministries will benefit as well.

Please note that both Blessed Sacrament and St. Anthony Daniel Parishes will be part of the Pilot Wave, meaning our kickoff will take place soon. St. Anthony Daniel will launch the Campaign on March 31. And Blessed Sacrament will launch its Campaign the weekend of April 6-7. We wanted to begin as early as possible to undertake the necessary projects that will improve our infrastructure and pastoral outreach. More information will be forthcoming to explain how the Campaign will be a win-win for the Diocese and our Parishes.

Finally, I would like to thank the volunteers who have offered to help with the Campaign. Our Co-Chairs for St. Anthony Daniel are Joan Kegels and Linda Mels. And for Blessed Sacrament, Blaine and Patti Field.
