




Share Lent: Collection today. Let us do our part to help the Church's mission in the parts of the world in need.

Campaign Update



Dear Parishioners:

As we enter the 3rd year of our very successful Campaign here are a few highlights from our respective parishes:

Blessed Sacrament:

One of the highest participation rate in the Diocese, at 67%. Pledges made: \$235,610. Pledges received: \$184,745. Thus far, 78.4 % of the pledges have been received. Since we reached our target goal of \$175,000 we qualified for the subsidy for parishes in need. That means we earned a net percentage of 10% or \$17,500. That means we are credited with \$200,783.25. Last year we spent approximately \$121,150 for the roof, ceiling and siding, and we paid down the debt to the Diocese, from \$99,000 (2019) to the current debt of \$24,000. As more donations come in we will be able to pay the rest of the debt off and begin the project to replace our AC units for the Church and Hall. Four years ago we were looking at a cumulative debt of over \$170,000, not to mention the major repairs that were still pending.

St. Anthony Daniel:

The highest participation rate in the Diocese at 73%. Pledges made: \$34,960. Pledges received: \$26,000. Once we reach our target goal of \$30,000 we will receive the net return of 25% or \$7,500. Once all the funds are in we will have \$41,716 on hand. With our reserve funds we were able to spend over \$11,000 for the new water system and the new HVAC. Prior to the pandemic we were making strides on getting estimates for the major church renovation, including accessibility. We hope to start the project again in the coming weeks. Jody Durand is helping out as the point person for the project.

Thanks to the generosity and commitment of the parishioners of both parishes, we have put our churches on a much better trajectory, not only fiscally, but also in the investments we have made for our ministry, facilities and outreach.
