



Easter Flowers: Please remember to make a donation for the Easter flowers using the special envelope. Your generosity will help to beautify the Church for the Easter celebration.





‘One Heart, One Soul’ kickoff is March 25

The One Heart, One Soul Campaign for the Diocese of Hamilton is about to reach high gear! The 14 Pilot Wave Parishes have been busy planning the projects of theirs that will benefit from the campaign, and a public kickoff Mass will be held at noon on Monday, March 25, Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord, at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King. The Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Douglas Crosby and followed by a reception at the Cathedral.

Please note that both Blessed Sacrament and St. Anthony Daniel Parishes will be part of the Pilot Wave, meaning our kickoff will take place soon.
