Last week I announced that the Parishes will invest more time and resource in our ministry to the migrant Farmworkers.

Thanks to our partnership with KAIROS, we have hired a part-time Service Coordinator, Deysi Kiernan, and we will be able to deliver services and materials to the workers as they arrive in Canada. One of our projects is to prepare and deliver welcome gift bags for each worker. Each bag will contain PPE, sanitizers, toiletries, socks and packaged food. Recently, Deysi and I met with the other team members to begin packaging our first batch of welcome bags. We have already delivered a number of them. Our goal is to deliver at least 500 in the Brant area. If you will be receiving any migrant workers, please contact the Office. We will prepare and deliver the bags to your main location for distribution. Please continue to pray for our new undertaking. We want to support our workers and local farming community.
