

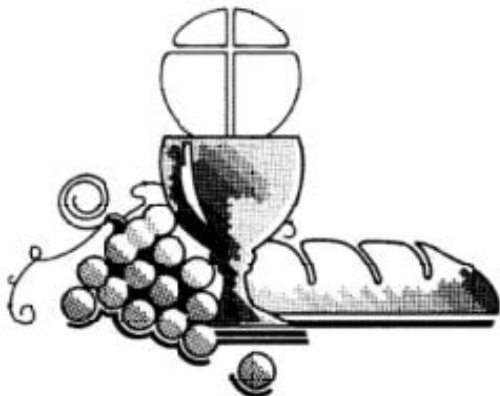

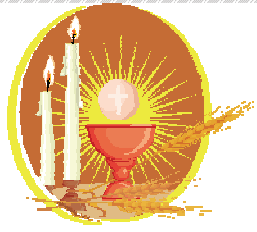
SICK & HOMEBOUND

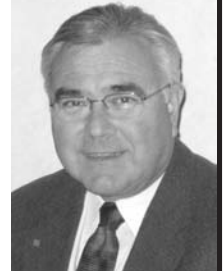
