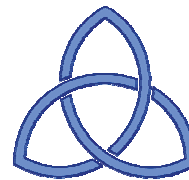

Holy Trinity Sunday

Dear Parishioners:

Today, the first Sunday after Pentecost, is the solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity. The mystery of the Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith. Through it, we learn who the one true God is and how He reveals himself to humanity, reconciling and uniting himself to us.

Christian belief in the Trinity was not the result of philosophical reflection on the nature of God. Rather, it developed as Christians reflected on their experience of salvation in Jesus Christ and the presence of His spirit - the spirit crying out to God, revealed by Christ as "Abba, Father" - within their very souls. The same God who saved the Jewish people from slavery in Egypt has also saved us through his Son, Jesus Christ. We can experience that salvation today at Mass through the ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Liturgically, we have returned to Ordinary Time. With a deeper sense of the recent Paschal mysteries, we are encouraged to be open to the action of divine Grace, to progress in love of God and of neighbour and to enter more deeply into the life of Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
