

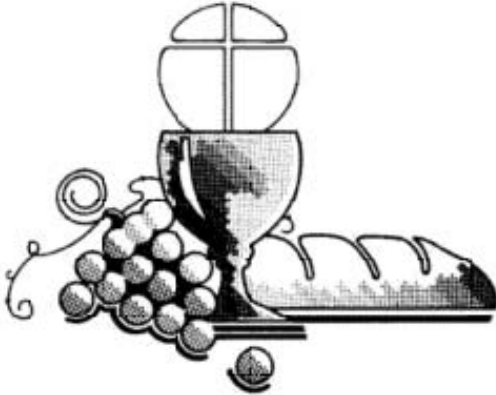

CATHOLIC FUNERALS

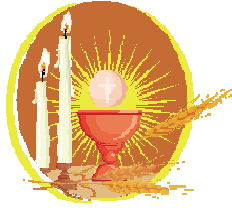

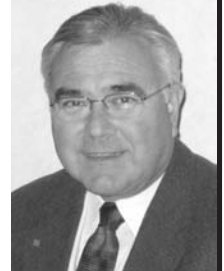
